Swainson's Hawk

The Swainson's Hawk eats voles and other small mammals, which they feed to their babies. They also eat agricultural pests such as grasshoppers and insects, especially during migration. When crops are harvested, certain prey animals become more scarce while others become more available.

Swainson's Hawks do not eat agricultural products such as fruit, grains and vegetables.


